Be sure to make your changes during your Summer Enrollment phase!





New Program Administrators



Effective September 1, 2023:

 EyeMed Vision Care, LLC (EyeMed) is the new administrator of the State of Texas Vision plan

Effective January 1, 2024

 Express Scripts will be the new administrator of the prescription drug program.

TEXFLEX



- Health care and limited-purpose FSA maximum increases from \$2,850 to \$3,050.
- A carryover of up to \$610 is allowed from the plan year ending August 31, 2024



If you want to increase to the maximum, you must do so during Summer Enrollment!

HealthSelect[™] benefit updates



Effective January 1, 2024

 In-network, out-of-pocket maximums increase to \$7,500 per person and \$15,000 per family

What is an out-of-pocket maximum?

 The most you have to pay for covered services in a plan year.



Pays you in the event your dependent passes away

Voluntary Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance



Voluntary AD&D

- For employees and their families.
- Covers in the event of accidental death or certain injuries for employees and their eligible dependents
- No EOI required

Log in to your ERS OnLine account to designate or update beneficiaries any time!





Texas Income Protection Plan (TIPP)

Short-term disability insurance

Pays up to 66% of your monthly salary for up to five months

Long-term disability insurance

 Pays up to 60% of your monthly salary – pay period depends on your age at the time of disability

EOI is required.
